In 2023, Recovery Day Winnipeg developed policies to help foster a safer and more inclusive event for everyone.

Recovery Day Safer Spaces Policy

EVERYONE has the right to experience the Recovery Day Winnipeg event as a safe place where they are respected and welcomed.

We believe that all people have the right to feel safe at Recovery Day Winnipeg regardless of where they are in their recovery journey, their age, ancestry, colour, family status, gender identity, gender expression, marital status, mental disability, physical disability, place of origin, race, religious beliefs, sexual orientation, source of income or housing.

Participant Conduct

The following code of conduct applies to anyone attending, working, volunteering, or performing at the Recovery Day Winnipeg event:

There is a Zero Tolerance Policy for: racism, ageism, sexism, misogyny, homophobia, queerphobia, transphobia, transmisogyny, whorephobia, ableism, classism, sizeism, sex-negativity, cultural appropriation, or any other behaviour or language that may perpetuate oppression.

If there is a breach of conduct and an incident is reported, the Recovery Day Winnipeg organizers will deal with the situation and follow up with an immediate course of action. The ideal response would be to take a restorative approach, but if deemed necessary, the accused will be removed from the event.

All concerns brought to the attention of RDW organizers will be taken seriously and action will be taken immediately.
